Re: Sonoma Clean Power Authority Registration Letter

Dear Mr. Syphers:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that Sonoma Clean Power Authority (SCPA) is registered as a Community Choice Aggregator by the California Public Utilities Commission.

Pursuant to Public Utilities (P.U.) Code Section 366.2(c)(17) "the community choice aggregator shall register with the commission, which may require additional information to ensure compliance with the basic consumer protection rules and other procedural matters." To implement this statute, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued Decision 05-12-041 adopting the following basic consumer protection requirements with which Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) programs must comply.

"Each CCA registration packet should be required to include (1) the CCA's service agreement with the serving utility; and (2) evidence of insurance or bond that will cover such costs as potential re-entry fees, penalties for failing to meet operational deadlines, and errors in forecasting."

Pursuant to Resolution E-4133, the CPUC requires an interim bond amount of \$100,000 (or that amount in cash) that a CCA shall post with the CPUC as part of their registration packet pursuant to Decision 05-12-041.

On August 22, 2013 the CPUC received the CCA service agreement that has been executed between Sonoma Clean Power Authority and Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E). The CCA service agreement was then approved by the CPUC on November 14th, 2013, in Resolution E-4324. On November 25, 2013 the CPUC received a check in the amount of \$100,000 from the SCPA, satisfying the SCPA's interim CCA bond requirement pursuant to CPUC Resolution E-4133.

With the submittal of the executed CCA Service with PG&E and the cash deposit of \$100,000, the SCPA has fulfilled the statutory mandate and regulatory requirements necessary to be registered as a CCA by the CPUC.

In conclusion, SCPA is hereby registered as a CCA in the State of California.
