




How to Process CTF Application

1) Log into eCAP account with username(email) and password




2) Each application is assigned a case number. To begin a new application, applicant will click "New CTF Application" button.




How to process CTF Application

3) The system will present a series of questions. Select "No" until you see the question that best describes your organization and select "Yes"

4) Enter the requested information on the Basic Information Tab.







How to process CTF Application

5) Libraries: Mobile Broadband Services:

The next tab will ask if the Applicant is requesting the CTF discount for mobile broadband services.

6) Libraries: Terms and Conditions and Submission






How to process CTF Application

7) Libraries" Save for Later". If the application is saved for a later submittal, it will appear in the list of applications with a status of Draft and will be assigned a Case Number.

8) Libraries: Submission. Once submitted, a confirmation message will appear, and the application 's status will change to submitted.

The California Teleconnect Fund

for Community Based Organizations and Healthcare Community Based Organizations

THE CALIFORNIA TELECONNECT FUND (CTF) provides qualifying Community Based Organizations (CBOs) and Healthcare Community Based Organizations (HCBOs) with a 50% discount on their monthly recurring broadband and advanced communication services.

How does it work?

- · Your organization submits a CTF application through their eCAP acount.
- CTF staff reviews the application and sends a determination letter to the organization
- Organization provides their service provider with the CTF Approval Letter
- Service provider applies a 50% discount to the organizations bill

Which Community Based Organizations or Healthcare Community Based Organizations qualify for the California Teleconnect Fund discount?

- File taxes with the IRS as a 501(c)(3) organization.
- Have annual revenue less than \$5,000,000 (CBO) or \$50,000,000 (HCBO).
- Have a board of directors, with the majority residing in California.
- Provide one or more of the following types of services directly to the community, as their primary function, without charge or at a minimal fee:
- » Regular, ongoing educational instruction (CBO)
 Examples include English as a Second Language (ESL) classes, Citizenship classes, or technology instruction classes.
- » Job Training/Placement (CBO)
- » Community Technology Center (CBO)
- Outpatient, walk-in Healthcare Services (HCBO only)

Applications are submitted through our online portal, eCAP.

Checklist

For Community Based Organizations

- √ IRS 501(c)(3) letter
- √ The most recent IRS Form 990
- A list of the board of directors and the state in which they reside.
- Qualifying Services Worksheet: The average monthly hours spent on each qualifying activity. Organizations that primarily use internet/broadband services for administrative and fundraising activities are not eligible for the CTF discount.

For Healthcare Community Based Organizations

- ✓ Proof of Medi-Cal, Medi-care or Dept of Veterans Affairs insurance (HCBO only)
- √ The name, titles, and license numbers of onsite medical practitioners (HCBO only)
- ✓ Healthcare fee document
- California Department of Public Health license number (HCBO only)
- ✓ Organizations that do not have a California Department of Public Health license number, but believe they are otherwise eligible for CTF may still apply. Analysts will evaluate eligibility on a case-bycase basis.
