Re: **Comcast's 52<sup>nd</sup> Amended Application for State Video Franchise**

To Whom it May Concern:

Comcast Cable Communications Management, LLC (“Comcast”) hereby submits its 52<sup>nd</sup> Amended Application for a State Video Franchise (“52<sup>nd</sup> Amended Application”) on behalf of itself and its affiliates. Comcast asks that the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) complete its processing of this application and issue the requested certificate modifying Comcast’s video franchise footprint under the state video franchise.

Comcast’s 52<sup>nd</sup> Amended Application seeks to increase Comcast’s Video Service Area to include the City of San Bruno (the “City”). The City currently owns and operates San Bruno CityNet (“SBCN”), which is a municipal cable system that does not operate pursuant to a state video franchise. Comcast and the City have reached an agreement by which Comcast will acquire the SBCN cable system. Accordingly, Comcast’s 52<sup>nd</sup> Amended Application will accommodate the transition of the SBCN cable system into Comcast’s existing state video franchise, and moving forward, Comcast its affiliates will provide service to the City’s video, broadband, and voice customers.
