VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited with having violated section(s) of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a Commission General Order (G.O.) as described below. These violations occurred during the period of April 1, 2023 to August 11, 2023.

- (1) Failed to enroll 10 employee-drivers in the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Employer Pull Notice (EPN) program, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5374(a)(1)(D) & 5381, and G.O. 157-E, Part 5.02. [10 counts]
- (2) Failed to enroll 10 employee-drivers in a mandatory Controlled Substance and Alcohol Testing Certification Program for Pre-Employment Testing, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5374(a)(1)(I) and G.O. 157-E, Part 10. [10 counts]
- (3) Failed to maintain records, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5381.5 & 5389 and G.O. 157-E, Part 6.01. [1 count]

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of the carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before February 14, 2024. By way of such answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$20,000 pursuant to P.U. Code Section 5378. (Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, or
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, or
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See the attached document "How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal."

If you fail to respond by February 14, 2024, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

INTRODUCTION

On July 28, 2023, I was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of Blackline Holdings Inc. (hereinafter referred to as Blackline) because of a Los Angeles International Airport Police Department complaint alleging that Blackline was involved in unfair business practices.

VIOLATIONS

I investigated Blackline for the period of April 1, 2023, to August 11, 2023, and found violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and a Commission General Order (G.O.):

Failed to enroll 10 employee-drivers¹ in the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV)
 Employer Pull Notice (EPN) program, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections
 5374(a)(1)(D) & 5381, and G.O. 157-E, Part 5.02 [10 counts].

Pub. Util. Code section 5374(a)(1)(D) states in part that, "The applicant participates in a program to regularly check the driving records of all persons, whether employees or subcarriers, operating vehicles used in transportation for compensation."

On November 21, 2023, Bezawit Dilgassa, Senior Enforcement Analyst of the Transportation Enforcement Branch (TEB) sent a Data Request letter to Uber, via the California Public Utilities Commission's (CPUC) secured Kiteworks database, requesting waybills generated by Blackline during the review period [Attachment 1]. On December 27, 2023, Uber responded via Kiteworks, providing a spreadsheet showing Blackline had 10 employee-drivers [Attachment 2 shows a sample of entries in a spreadsheet]. A search of Blackline's DMV EPN program with requester code shows Blackline has been enrolled in the program since February 13, 2023. The program shows Blackline's Director, Arthur Arakelyan (hereinafter referred to as Mr.

On December 27, 2023, Uber responded to CPED data request and Uber provided a "Confidential was a spreadsheet (waybill log) from Uber showing Blackline had 33 drivers operating with the carrier. Due to the massive amount of data, a sample of 10 drivers for the following dates May 18-20, and June 15, 2023, will be used to substantiate the DMV EPN and Drug Program violation.

Arakelyan), as the only one enrolled in the program, but not the 10 employee-drivers listed in **Table 1 [Attachment 3 and Footnote 1].** My investigation disclosed that Blackline's 10 employee-drivers operated for 4 days and completed 242 trips without evidence of enrollment in the DMV EPN program [Table 1 and Attachment 2].

• Failed to enroll 10 employee-drivers in a mandatory Controlled Substance and Alcohol Testing Certification Program for Pre-Employment Testing, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5374(a)(1)(I) and G.O. 157-E, Part 10 [10 counts].

G.O. 157-E, Part 10.01 states in part that, "All charter-party carrier applicants who propose to employ any driver who will operate a vehicle having a seating capacity of 15 persons or less, including the driver, must provide for a mandatory controlled substance and alcohol testing certification program for those drivers as required by the G.O. unless all such drivers are already covered by federal testing regulations."

On August 22, 2023, a Data Request [Attachment 4] was sent to Blackline via U.S. certified mail with the attention to the CEO, Artak Aghajanyan (hereinafter referred to as Mr. Aghajanyan) requesting for Blackline's current service agreement with their Drug Consortium and a list of all drivers enrolled showing dates added and/or deleted. On September 5, 2023, I received an email from Chris Delgado (hereinafter referred to as Mr. Delgado), Drug Consortium

Representative at CM & Associates, Inc., stating that he was writing on behalf of Mr. Aghajanyan of Blackline [Attachment 5]. In the email, Mr. Delgado stated that a drug test for one driver was submitted to the CPUC on February 23, 2023, and attached the Form PL 706-J (Controlled Substances and Alcohol Testing Certification Program), indicating that the 10 employee-drivers listed in **Table 1** [Footnote 1] were not enrolled in the drug consortium program.

• Failure to maintain records, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5381.5 & 5389 and G.O. 157-E, Part 6.01 [1 count].

G.O. 157-E, Part 6.01 states in part that, "Every carrier shall institute and maintain in its offices, a set of records which reflect information as to the services performed, including waybills, as described in Section 3.01. Such records shall be maintained for a minimum period of three years."

On August 22, 2023, a Data Request [see Attachment 4] was sent to Blackline via U.S. certified mail with the attention to Mr. Aghajanyan. On September 5, 2023, Mr. Delgado emailed a response to the Data Request, stating that he was writing on behalf of Mr. Aghajanyan of Blackline [see Attachment 5]. On September 8, 2023, I sent an email to Mr. Delgado and Blackline (requesting that Blackline submit in writing in what capacity Mr. Delgado represents Blackline. Mr. Delgado withdrew from the email correspondence and Blackline responded to my emails instead. There was never any confirmation from Blackline regarding Mr. Delgado's connection with the company besides being their Drug Consortium Representative. I advised Blackline that the Data Request is still required and granted Blackline an extension of September 15, 2023.

On September 19, 2023, Blackline provided Form PL 706-J and Worker's Compensation Insurance as attachments [Attachment 6]. On September 20, 2023, I requested, via email, that Blackline provide waybills, but I received only the LAX circuit charge report on the same day [Attachment 7] contains one representative sample]. On October 2, 2023, I contacted Blackline via telephone and email to inform them that the LAX circuit charge report was not a waybill and was unacceptable [see Attachment 7]. On December 27, 2023, Uber provided confidential records

[Footnote 1] showing Blackline had waybills for May 18, 2023 to June 15, 2023. My investigation disclosed that Blackline failed to maintain the requested records.



The California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division (CPED) Transportation Enforcement Branch (TEB) is currently reviewing the Commission's records for intrastate transportation carriers that are regulated by the Commission.

Public Utilities Code Section 5389 authorizes the Commission and its staff to have access at any time to the land, buildings, or equipment of a charter-party carrier of passengers used in connection with the operation of its business and may inspect the accounts, books, papers, and documents of the carrier.

General Order 157-E, Part 6.01 specifically states in part that every carrier shall institute and maintain in its offices a set of records which reflect information as to the transportation services performed, including waybills, driver records, and safety and maintenance records including copies of all lease and sub-carrier agreements. Such records shall be maintained for a minimum period of three years.

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 5389, the Commission is requesting a review of the Charter-Party intrastate transportation records for Blackline Holdings Inc. Failure to provide access to records is a misdemeanor punishable by a maximum of \$5,000, or by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding one year, or by both fine and imprisonment, where each violation is a separate and distinct offense (Public Utilities Code Section 2110).

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES AND ALCOHOL TESTING CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

I. GENERAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

All passenger stage and charter-party applicants who propose to employ drivers who will operate vehicles having a seating capacity of 15 persons or less, including the driver, must comply with the Commission's controlled substance and alcohol testing certification program requirements detailed below. Charter-party applicants who propose to employ drivers who will operate vehicles with a seating capacity of 16 persons or more, including the driver, must comply with the federal drug testing requirements for those drivers. If all of your drivers will operate vehicles with a seating capacity of 16 persons or more, you do not have to comply with the state drug testing program or complete part II below. If this is the case, sign and date on the line directly below and complete parts III and IV.

(A person who employs himself/herself as a driver is considered an employer for the purposes of these requirements.)

Public Utilities Code Section 5374 provides that:

The commission shall not issue or renew a charter-party carrier permit or certificate unless the applicant provides for a mandatory controlled substance and alcohol testing certification program as adopted by the commission pursuant to Section 1032.1.

Public Utilities Code Section 1032.1 states that:

1032.1 (a) The commission shall not issue a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to this article unless the applicant provides for a mandatory controlled substance and alcohol testing certification program as adopted by the commission.

(b) The commission, after considering any suggestions made by the Department of the California Highway Patrol, shall adopt a program that includes, but need not be limited to, all of the following requirements:

(1) Drivers shall test negative for each of the controlled substances specified in Part 40 (commencing with Section 40.1) of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, before employment. Drivers shall test negative for these controlled substances and for alcohol at such other times as the commission, after consulting the Department of the California Highway Patrol, shall designate. As used in this section, a negative test for alcohol means an alcohol screening test showing a breath alcohol concentration of less than 0.02 percent.

(2) Procedures shall be substantially as in Part 40 (commencing with Section 40.1) of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, except that the driver shall show a valid California driver's license at the time and place of testing, and except as provided otherwise in this section. Requirements for rehabilitation and for return-to-duty and follow-up testing, and other requirements except as provided otherwise in this section, shall be substantially as in Part 382 (commencing with Section 382.101) of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

(3) A test for one applicant shall be accepted as meeting the same requirement for any other applicant. Any negative test result shall be accepted for one year as meeting any requirement for periodic testing for that applicant or any other applicant, if the driver has not tested positive subsequent to a negative result. However, an earlier negative result shall not be accepted as meeting the pre-employment testing requirement for any subsequent employment, or any testing requirements under the program other than periodic testing.

(4) In the case of an applicant who is also a driver, test results shall be reported directly to the commission. In all other cases, results shall be reported directly to the applicant.

(5) All test results are confidential and shall not be released without the consent of the driver, except as authorized or required by law.

(6) Applicants shall be responsible for compliance with, and shall pay all costs of, this program with respect to their employees and potential employees, except that an applicant may require employees who test positive to pay the costs of rehabilitation and of return-to-duty and follow-up testing.

- (7) The requirements of the program do not apply to any driver required to comply with the controlled substance and alcohol. use and testing requirements of Part 382 (commencing with Section 382.101) of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, or Section 34520 of the Vehicle Code, or to any driver exempted from the provisions of that section.
- (c) No evidence derived from a positive test result pursuant to the program shall be admissible in a criminal prosecution concerning unlawful possession, sale or distribution of controlled substances.
- (d) On the request of an applicant, the commission shall give the applicant a list of consortia certified pursuant to Part 382 (commencing with Section 382.101) of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations that the commission knows offer tests in California.
- (e) The commission shall conduct random and for-cause inspections of applicants' documents supporting compliance with the program.
 - (f) For purposes of this section, "employment" includes self-employment as an independent driver.

Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 382; Controlled Substance and Alcohol Use and Testing

To fully understand what is required of you under the CFR, you must obtain a copy of Parts 40 and 382 and become familiar with their directives or obtain one of the controlled substance and alcohol testing program training kits now available on the market.

The following is a brief summary of Part 382.

The CFR requires employers to provide educational materials to their drivers which explain the requirements of Part 382 and the employer's policies and procedures with respect to meeting these requirements (382.601). Further, Part 49 requires employers to provide for a comprehensive drug testing program to ensure that drivers do not operate vehicles while being impaired by alcohol or controlled substances.

Every carrier must conduct pre-employment testing (382.301), post-accident testing (382.303), random testing (382.305 testing due to reasonable suspicion (382.307), follow-up testing (382.311), and return-to-duty testing (382.309).

Employers must advise employees of the resources available to them to resolve problems associated with the misuse c alcohol and the use of controlled substances (382.605).

Employers must ensure that supervisors are properly trained to determine whether reasonable suspicion exists to require a driver to undergo testing (382.603).

Employers shall not permit an employee who has violated the provisions of Part 382 to perform safety-sensitive functions including driving a commercial vehicle.

Title 49 of the CFR Part 40: Procedures for Transportation Workplace Drug Testing Programs

Part 40 provides for the specific procedures for conducting alcohol and controlled substance tests.
