#### **VIOLATIONS**

You are hereby cited as having violated section(s) of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order (G.O) as described below. These violations occurred during the period of December 1, 2023, through March 31, 2024.

- Operated at an airport without an airport permit and failure to follow airport rules and regulations, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5371.4(b), 5381, and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02 [2 counts]; and
- Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) after revocation of authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379 [1 count].

#### **STATEMENT OF FACTS**

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of the carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

#### **RESPONSE**

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before June 18, 2024. By way of such an answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of **\$4,000** pursuant to Pub. Util. Code Section 5378. Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the CPUC staff will deem the matter closed), or
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, or
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an appeal. See the attached document "How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certification of Service for a Citation Appeal."

If you fail to respond by June 18, 2024, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

#### INTRODUCTION

On February 20, 2024, I was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of Erhan Kantarci dba Welcome Limousine U.S (hereinafter referred to as Erhan Kantarci) because of a citation issued by the San Francisco International Airport (SFO) Ground Transportation Unit (GTU), showing that Erhan Kantarci operated on a revoked CPUC authority, and without an airport permit.

#### HISTORY OF ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement case records show Erhan Kantarci has a history of violating CPUC's rules and regulations, as detailed below:

**Prior Case (PSG-5197)**: On November 25, 2020, CPUC's Transportation Enforcement Analyst, Omar Teutle, served Erhan Kantarci with Citation F-5728 in the amount of \$2,000 for the following violations [**Attachment 1**]:

- Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) after suspension of authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379. [1 count]
- Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) without evidence of Public Liability and Property Damage (PL&PD) insurance coverage in effect and on file with the Commission, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5391 and G.O. 115-F and 157-E, Part 1.05 [1 count]

#### **VIOLATIONS**

I investigated Erhan Kantarci for the period of December 1, 2023, through March 31, 2024, and found violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and CPUC General Order (G.O.):

• Operated at an airport without an airport permit and failure to follow airport rules and regulations, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5371.4(b), 5381, and G.O. 157-E, Part 3.02. [2 counts]

On December 3, 2023, SFO GTU issued Citation to Erhan Kantarci [Attachment 2] for operating without an airport permit. On March 19, 2024, I sent a Notice to Cease and Desist via email to Erhan Kantarci at [Attachment 3]. On March 30, 2024, SFO GTU issued Citation to Erhan Kantarci [Attachment 4] for operating without an airport permit.

• Operated as a Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) after revocation of authority, in violation of Pub. Util. Code Section 5379. [1 count]

On February 19, 2020, the Transportation Licensing and Analysis Branch (TLAB) mailed an Order of Revocation for failure to maintain adequate Public Liability and Property Damage (PL&PD) insurance [Attachment 5]. Pub. Util. Code 5379 states in part that "After the cancellation or revocation of a permit or certificate, or during the period of its suspension, or after the expiration of its permit or certificate, it is unlawful for a charter-party carrier of passengers to conduct any operations as a carrier". On March 30, 2024, SFO GTU issued Citation to Erhan Kantarci [see Attachment 4] for operating on a revoked CPUC authority.

#### NOTICE TO CEASE AND DESIST

Dear Erhan Kantarci:

On February 19, 2020, your Charter-Party Carrier (TCP) authority was revoked for Failure to maintain Public Liability and Property Damage (PL&PD) Insurance.

Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code Section 5379 states in part that it is unlawful for a TCP to conduct any operations after cancellation or revocation, or during the period of its suspension, or after the expiration of its authority. Pub. Util. Code Section 5414.5 states that it is unlawful to publish or advertise without a valid authority. Advertisements include, but are not limited to, advertising in local directories or Yellow Pages, business cards, websites, etc.

Welcome Limousine U.S., must immediately cease and desist from all unlawful operations, including advertising. Pub. Util. Code Section 5411 states in part that any carrier which operates without a valid authority is guilty of a misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine not less than \$1,000.

This letter places your company on notice that continued violations of the law without the required operating authority may result in enforcement actions, including criminal prosecutions. There will be no further warnings.

#### ORDER OF REVOCATION

The OPERATING AUTHORITY(S) LISTED ABOVE IS REVOKED IF NOT OTHERWISE EXPIRED effective February 19, 2020 for the following reason:

Failure to Maintain Adequate Insurance

PL and PD Policy#

Any carrier which operates with revoked operating authority(s) is guilty of a misdemeanor which is punishable by a fine of not less than \$1,000 or imprisonment of up to three months, or both. Additionally, Public Utilities Code Section 5387(c)(1) provides that a carrier which operates a bus without holding operating authority from the Commission shall be permanently barred from receiving a permit or certificate from the Commission.

NOTE: FOR CHARTER-PARTY CARRIERS, ALL LIVERY LICENSE PLATES MUST BE RETURNED TO THE COMMISSION IMMEDIATELY UPON REVOCATION OF YOUR OPERATING AUTHORITY.

YOU MAY REQUEST REINSTATEMENT OF YOUR AUTHORITY WITHIN 90 DAYS OF REVOCATION BY FILING A WRITTEN REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT ACCOMPANIED BY A \$125 FILING FEE. IF YOU FAIL TO HAVE YOUR AUTHORITY REINSTATED BEFORE May 19, 2020 YOU MUST REAPPLY AND PAY \$1,000 APPLICATION FEE (\$1,500 FOR AN "A" CERTIFICATE).

### IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING OPERATIONS WITHOUT AN ACTIVE PERMIT OR CERTIFICATE

The Public Utilities Code was amended effective January 1, 2010, to provide serious sanctions for, among other things, conducting operations during a period of liability insurance suspension or conducting operations without a permit or certificate from the Commission. Section 5387(c)(1) was added to the Code as follows:

- (c)(1) A charter-party carrier shall have its authority to operate as a charter-party carrier permanently revoked by the Commission or be permanently barred from receiving a permit or certificate from the Commission if it commits any of the following acts:
- (A) Operates one or more buses or vehicles without having been issued a permit or certificate from the Commission.
- (B) Operates one or more buses with a permit that was suspended by the Commission pursuant to Section 5378.5.
- (C) Commits three or more liability insurance violations within a two-year period for which it has been cited.
- (D) Operates one ore more buses or vehicles with a permit that was suspended by the Commission during a period that the charter-party carrier's liability insurance lapsed for which it has been cited.
- (E) Knowingly employs a driver who does not have a current and valid driver's license of the proper class, a passenger vehicle endorsement, or the required certificate to drive bus(es) or vehicle(s).
- (F) Has one or more buses or vehicles improperly registered with the Department of Motor Vehicles.
