VIOLATIONS

You are hereby cited with having violated section(s) of the Public Utilities Code (P.U. Code) and California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) General Order (G.O.) as described below. This violation occurred on April 10, 2024.

(1) Failed to produce access to records in violation of P.U. Code Sections 5389 and 5413 and G.O. 157-E Part 6.02 [1 count]

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The above violations are documented in the attached Investigation Report, which consists of the carrier's records and substantiating documents obtained from other sources.

RESPONSE

TEB used the Penalty Assessment Methodology adopted in Resolution M-4846 and considered mitigating and exacerbating factors in setting the fine.

You are hereby called upon to answer this citation on or before June 10, 2024. By way of such answer, you may either:

- (1) Pay a fine of \$2,000 pursuant to P.U. Code Section 5378. (Submit your check or money order payable to California Public Utilities Commission using the attached *Citation Agreement*. Upon payment, the fine will be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund and the Commission staff will deem the matter closed, **or**
- (2) Contact the Supervisor below to make payment arrangements, or
- (3) Contest this Citation by filing an Appeal. See attached document "How to File an Appeal and Instructions for Filing a Notice of Appeal and Certificate of Service for a Citation Appeal."

If you fail to respond by June 10, 2024, you will be in default and will have forfeited your right to appeal the Citation. In addition, your operating authority will be immediately suspended and may be subsequently revoked pursuant to Resolution ALJ-187. The Commission may also act through a civil or criminal proceeding to recover any unpaid fine and ensure compliance with applicable statutes and Commission orders.

INTRODUCTION

On January 8, 2024, I was assigned to investigate the operations and practices of Alva Limolux LLC, hereinafter referred to as Alva, because Alva was allegedly operating with more vehicles and drivers than what was reported to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission).

VIOLATIONS

I investigated Alva from January 8, 2024, to May 22, 2024, and found violations of the following provisions of the Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code and Commission General Orders (G.O.):

• Alva failed to provide access to records in violation of Pub. Util. Code Sections 5389 and 5413 and G.O. 157-E Part 6.02 [1 count].

On March 21, 2024, I sent Alva a data request [Attachment 1] via the Transportation Charter Party (TCP) Portal to _______, with a due date of April 9, 2024. On March 25, 2024, Alex Vayner, one of the three owners of Alva, called me because he had questions regarding his TCP permit. I directed Mr. Vayner to our Transportation Licensing and Analysis Branch (TLAB). Mr. Vayner stated he would have the information requested by the end of March 2024. Following our conversation, I sent an email recapping our conversation [Attachment 2]. To date, Alva still has not provided any records to me.

DECLARATION

I have read the foregoing and know the contents thereof and I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct, except as to those matters stated on information and belief, and to those matters, I believe to be true.

Subject: Data Request

Dear Edward Vayner:

The California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division (CPED) Transportation Enforcement Branch (TEB) is currently reviewing the Commission's records for intrastate transportation carriers that are regulated by the Commission.

Public Utilities Code Section 5389 authorizes the Commission and its staff to have access at any time to the land, buildings, or equipment of a charter-party carrier of passengers used in connection with the operation of its business and may inspect the accounts, books, papers, and documents of the carrier.

General Order 157-E, Part 6.01 specifically states in part that every carrier shall institute and maintain in its offices a set of records which reflect information as to the transportation services performed, including waybills, driver records, and safety and maintenance records including copies of all lease and sub-carrier agreements. Such records shall be maintained for a minimum period of three years.

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 5389, the Commission is requesting a review of the Charter-Party intrastate transportation records for Alva Limolux LLC. Failure to provide access to records is a misdemeanor punishable by a maximum of \$5,000, or by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding one year, or by both fine and imprisonment, where each violation is a separate and distinct offense (Public Utilities Code Section 2110).
