9.1.1: DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR

During 2024, Comcast California attended monthly meetings of the Supplier Diversity Council of California, and a monthly working group focused on increasing awareness of procurement opportunities for the CPUC's certified suppliers. Comcast California also attended approximately 30 events with small and diverse businesses, including ten matchmaking sessions, attended eight panel discussions, and participated in events that supported various community organizations.

10.1.2: PLANNED ACTIVITIES

Comcast California plans to continue internal and external activities similar to those described in response to 9.1.1 above. In addition, Comcast California intends to continue tracking when its eligible suppliers' Commission certifications will expire.

10.1.3: RECRUITING CERTAIN CATEGORIES OF ELIGIBLE SUPPLIERS
