Purpose:

The purpose of Workshop #1 is to discuss the Definition of Scoped Work within the context of the Risk-based Decision-making Framework (RDF). Scoped work is a disaggregation of mitigation programs that allows Staff, parties and decisionmakers to have a granular understanding of risk reduction. The principles of scoped work include being forecastable and auditable as well as capable of being scheduled, mapped, and prioritized. The workshop will also discuss if an alternate terminology, such as the Risk Reporting Unit, may be a better fit for the RDF.

Expected Outcome: Workshop attendees will provide feedback on the benefits, costs, and any additional revisions related to how the Commission should define "scoped work" or some derivative term.
